## AR15 American Rifle match (ARAR) Description - 2020

This competition is open to the public and is approved by the NRA. The Guidebook states that "...events are designed for shooters of all skill levels..." and "...millions of gun owners have purchased AR..."

The program for the ARAR match is as follows:

1. The calendar of the ARAR for **2020** is:

March 15 (Sunday)
April 11 (Saturday)
May 9 (Saturday)
June 14 (Sunday)
July 11 (Saturday)
August 15 (Sunday).

- 2. The competition is the AR Match (Basic) as defined by the NRA.
- 3. It consists of 8 stages, 4 positions, and 72 rounds fired.
- 4. Any type of sight is permitted: iron, optics no magnification, and optics with magnification.
- 5. The targets are at distances of 100, 50, 25, and 7 yards.
- 6. First shot at 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. or until finished.
- 7. The initial stage will be at 100 yards. Competitors then move forward to 50, 25, and 7 yards, always using the 100 yards line of the combination range.
- 8. The bullseye is a 6" hexagon at all distances.
- 9. Cost to competitor is \$10 (Member's Guest fee is \$20.00)
- 10. There is no water, food, or ammo at the range.
