## RENEWAL PERIOD OPEN:

The annual membership renewal period is now open online. You can log into your Fusilier Complex account and renew your membership for the 2021/2022 shooting year. If you paid your membership last year through the website, you will renew this year the same way. If you mailed in your renewal last year, you will receive a renewal form by mail, but you are encouraged to renew online. We have created an account for all members who submitted paper renewals. Simply login with your username (firstnamelastname) lowercase and no space. If you are not prompted to enter a new password, click 'Forgot

Password' and you will be able to enter a new password. If you are not going to use the website to renew, you can download a renewal application and mail it in. PLEASE NOTE: Paper renewals will not be processed until after the annual member meeting.

**Bathrooms:** As you may have noticed the new bathroom buildings are nearly complete. We are looking forward the finishing this project in the coming months.

**Action Bay:** The big dig for the Action Bay began earlier this year, but we've had to put the project on hold due to a combination of cooperating weather and equipment availability. We estimate we will need about 2 weeks of dry weather when the heavy equipment is available to complete the dig. Once the dig is complete, there will be a physical barrier installed between the Action Bay and the Handgun Only Line.

## BY LAWS update:

For some time now there has been discussion of updating our club's bylaws. This year, we will be proposing bylaw updates. We will not update all bylaws, but we will take two of the bylaws into consideration. The two bylaws in question will be emailed to the membership prior to the annual meeting. The proposed updates will be voted on and documented as needed. Moving forward, additional bylaws will be presented for change at future membership meetings until the whole body of bylaws has been reviewed and updated where needed.

## Long Range Committee:

This year a committee was formed to review, design and propose a long range for the club. They have held regular meetings to discuss different options for adding a new long range to the Fusilier Complex. This committee will be presenting their proposal at the membership meeting.

## Stop the Bleed:

The Fusilier Complex is going to partner with Ochsner Lafayette General Medical Center to offer 'Stop the Bleed' basic trauma aid, (how pack a wound, apply pressure, and use a tourniquet). This will be free to members.

**Firearms Instructors:** Last year, the Executive Committee asked for all members who are firearms instructors, (CHL, Safety, etc.) to notify the Executive Committee. We received information from several instructors and are going to meet with this group in the coming weeks. The purpose is to review their use of the range and how we can ensure it is used consistently with all instructors. During this meeting, the instructors, along with Executive Committee members, will establish guidelines for all instructors to use at the range when conducting a class.

**RSOs:** Earlier this year, The Fusilier Complex held a NRA Range Safety Officer training session. We are happy to announce there were 15 new RSO's added to our roster. This brings to the total number of RSO's to 40.

**New Committees:** The Fusilier Complex is looking to form two new committees to assist with growing the club and expanding the opportunities for our members. We are going to

form a Range Improvement Committee and a Competition Committee. More details on the requirements of these committees will be discussed.

### **Fusilier Complex Website:**

We have a few new enhancements which have made to the website. We have added a 'Download' section for members to download club related documents. These documents include: Range Rules, Match Rules, News Letters, ByLaws, etc. The Forums section will now include a section for members who have a firearm related business.
